Characteristics of Class:

Must be peace officer certified. Performs duties in the investigation and rendering safe of explosive devices, explosives and arson related offenses; and performs other duties as required.

Minimum Requirements:

Education: High School Graduate

Experience: Five years experience or college education involving explosives and/or hazardous devices used in the areas of law enforcement, the military or firefighting.

Examples of Duties:

Investigates explosive complaints, suspected bombs and explosives related offenses. Renders safe bombs, explosives, hazardous chemicals and disposal of these items as required. Coordinates Kentucky State Police activities involving training law enforcement and fire departments in explosive operations. Conducts on-site examinations of scenes involving explosives and arson related offenses to collect physical evidence, photographs and sketches of scenes. Arrests and interrogates suspects. Prepares detailed reports of explosives and hazardous devices investigations. Operates specialized explosive disposal equipment and conducts disposal operations. Performs other duties as required.
